Thank you for your interest in the Casting Instructor's Workshop in Sonoma, CA.

This workshop is scheduled for the weekend of **Saturday & Sunday - May 21 & 22, 2011**. It will run between the hours of 8 AM and 6 PM Saturday and Sunday. The student teacher ratio is never greater than 5:1 so the workshop will be limited to no more than 10 students. **The class will not be held if less than 3 people are scheduled to attend by the cut-off date of May 7, 2011.** The classroom and field portions will be held in a well-equipped and comfortable environment on site at:

What to bring:

Bring your rod of choice up to 7 wt, 9 foot (9 foot, 6 or 7 wt rod recommended), with **Floating Line** (preferably orange or other highly visible color) and a tapered leader about 9 ft, 2X or 3X with no tippet (yarn flies will be supplied). We recommend a leader tip diameter no lighter than 3X. Dress properly and expect the possibility of rain or hot sun, bring protective glasses, sun lotion, bug lotion and a hat. We will cast regardless of the weather.

Be prepared to contribute in both the classroom and the field sessions.

This workshop is scheduled to run between the hours of 8 AM and 6 PM Saturday and Sunday. To insure a low student to teacher ratio the workshop will be limited to no more than 10 people. The classroom portions will be held in a well-equipped and comfortable environment. The field portions will be held in an appropriate location at the same site.

All students will be provided a workbook with the information presented in class as well as a number of other pertinent handouts. Pens and notepads will be supplied.

Breakfast and lunch will be provided both days as well coffee and water. A group dinner may be held on Saturday evening depending on participation. You will be responsible for your own evening meal costs.

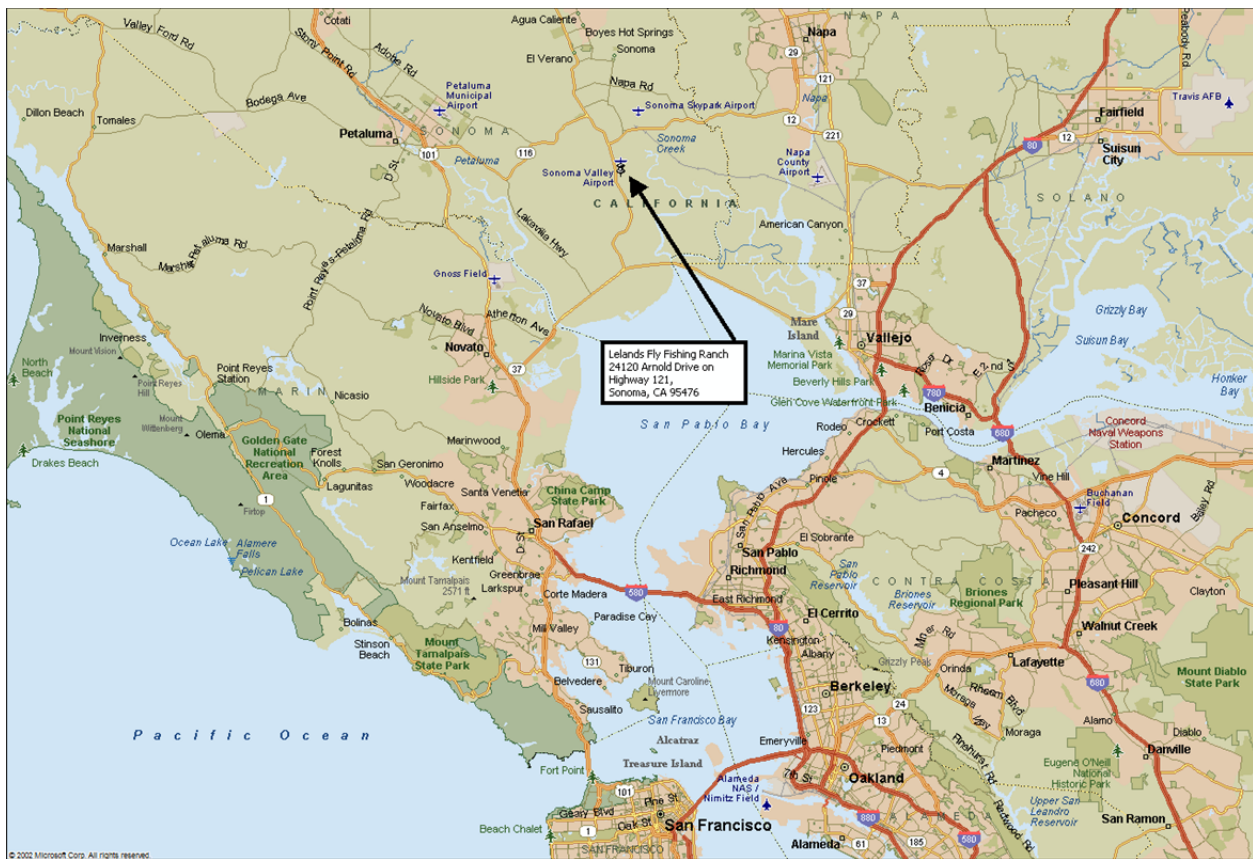
Lodging

Finding the Location:

The workshop will be held in the heart of California's Wine growing country at Lelands Fly Fishing Ranch in Sonoma, CA.

The ranch is situated approximately 35 miles north of San Francisco and Oakland on Hwy 121 about 4.5 miles north of Infineon Raceway. The property borders the Sonoma County Airport on the east side of the highway.
